Career Exploration Activities: How to Help Your Students ...

Print out a chart with one letter of the alphabet in each box, and have students fill in careers that start with each letter. Career Crossover - To help students process career day information, gather together to create Venn diagrams to explore similarities and differences in the careers they heard about. If they heard about computers and art, designing computer games might be a good career; if they like pets and psychology, maybe they could be an animal behaviorist.

Some specific career needs targeted at elementary school-aged students include: A systematic process that will enable children to develop sound educational and career plans (Starr, 1996), exploration of how self fits with specific careers (McIntosh, 2000), and a focus on values, interests, and abilities-- not on gender role stereotypes (Lupaschuk & Yewchuk, 1998).
