History of the theory. The theory is based on an interpretation of demographic history developed in 1929 by the American demographer Warren Thompson (1887–1973). Adolphe Landry of France made similar observations on demographic patterns and population growth potential around 1934. In the 1940s and 1950s Frank W. Notestein developed a more formal theory of demographic transition.

The world's Christian population is expected to grow from 2.2 billion in 2010 to 2.9 billion in 2050. 39 Nearly one-in-three people worldwide (31%) are expected to be Christian at mid-century, the same share as in 2010. While the overall share of the world's population that is Christian is expected to remain relatively steady, the regional distribution of Christians is projected to change.
